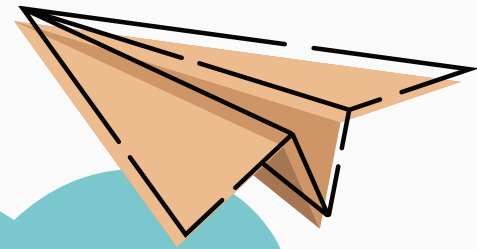




PAPER PLANE GAME



WHAT YOU NEED:

Poster board or Cardboard
Cutter
Letter-size paper
Marker
String or yarn

PRO TIPS:

1. Consistently use your child's visual schedule especially when moving from one activity to another.

INSTRUCTIONS:

1. Create paper planes.
2. Cut holes in a piece of poster board or cardboard and assign a point value to each.
3. Hang the poster board/cardboard.
4. Have your child send their paper airplanes soaring towards the holes of the poster board or cardboard.



DURATION:
10-15 minutes

Encourage your child to help you plan and set up the activity at the start.
